 - iii. They conduct an annual Symposium. In 2023, there were 900 abstracts submitted.
 - iv. There is potential for beneficial collaboration through workshops and short courses and other connections where it makes sense.
 - v. We discussed the potential for joint sessions with M&E and the ARMA at the Annual Conference.
