The MPD/Richard Klimpel Scholarships are open to undergraduate or graduate students.

APPLICANT QUALIFICATIONS	Mineral & Metallurgical Processing Division and Klimpel Scholarship applicants must meet the following criteria: 1. Have completed at least one year of undergraduate studies with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.8. 2. Be an SME student member in good standing. 3. Attend a school that is ABET accredited and/or has an SME student chapter. 4. Demonstrate a desire for and a probability of success in a career in mineral/metallurgical processing.		
APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS	MPD/Klimpel Scholarship applications must be submitted online via SME's scholarship portal smenet.org/students/grants-scholarships . The online application requires the following information: 1. Demographic and contact information. 2. Short statement (one page) describing applicant's interest in/passion for a career in mineral/mettalurgical processing. 3. Two references, one from university faculty and one from an appropriate industry professional.		
	4. Résumé detailing past education and work experience.5. Copy of most recent transcript (unofficial transcripts are OK).6. Anticipated expenses/income for the current academic year.		
RECIPIENT SELECTION	Selection of scholarship recipients is at the discretion of SME's Mineral & Metallurgical Processing Division Scholarship Committee.

	Richard Klimpel Memorial Scholarship : The Outstanding Senior receives the Richard Klimpel Memorial Scholarship in the amount of \$7,500 plus expenses to attend the SME Annual Conference & Expo. The expenses covered shall be travel, hotel and conference registration only. Additional expenses such as meals, in-town transportation and other incidentals shall be the student's responsibility.	
AWARD	MPD Scholarships : Additional MPD scholarships may be awarded annually at the discretion of the MPD Scholarship Committee. The recommendations for the eight additional scholarships are:	
	Outstanding Junior: \$4,000	
	Outstanding Graduate Student: \$4,000	
	Two Undergraduate Student Scholarships: \$1,500 each	
	One Graduate Student Scholarships: \$2,000 each
