

UCA LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

Guidelines & Procedures

OVERVIEW	The Lifetime Achievement Award recognizes individuals with outstanding achievements in the underground design and construction industry accomplished through design and/or construction of civil underground facilities.

NOMINATIONS & ELIGIBILITY	 The nominee must have contributed significantly to the education, planning, design, construction, or rehabilitation of tunnels and underground facilities. This includes seeking advances in new methods, materials, and advancing the public understanding and concurrence with the beneficial uses of underground space. The nominee must have a minimum of 20 years of professional experience anywhere in the world and have spent most of his/her career in underground construction. Contributed significantly to the industry, UCA, ITA or other underground organizations. The nominee should be a UCA member in good standing at the time of the award. A minimum of three nominations need to be received and evaluated for each award in order to select a winner. Current voting members of the SME Board of Directors, UCA Executive Committee, or Award Committees, are NOT eligible for any awards that they are responsible for approving during their term, with the exception of "past chair" recognitions. No person is eligible to receive more than one SME, UCA or SME/AIME award in a single year. 	
SELECTION OF RECIPIENTS	The Award Committee will recommend to the Executive Committee a recipient they determine best represents the intent of this award. The UCA Executive Committee is required to review and confirm the Awards Committee recommendation.	
AWARD	The UCA Muddy Boots Award is plaque engraved with the recipient's name and year of the award. The recipient will also receive a complimentary registration to the event where the award is given and a one year UCA membership.	
PRESENTATION OF The Award	The award will be presented annually at a UCA event. There may be only one awardee per year.	
FUNDING	All expenses incurred in respect of the Award shall be the financial responsibility of general Underground Construction Division funds.	
AMENDMENTS	These guidelines may be amended by the Award Committee, subject to approval by the UCA Executive Committee. Any such amendments must be reflected in all appropriate award documentation.
