SCHOLARSHIP	Scholarship recipients will receive:  • A one-year student membership to UCA • Conference Registration with access to the technical sessions and exhibit hall • Invitation to the UCA Young Member Networking Event and the Scholarship Orientation • Conference Proceedings • Up to \$1,000 will be reimbursed for travel to the conference, hotel, ground transportation and meals.

APPLICANT QUALIFICATIONS	All applicants must meet the following criteria:  • A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5  • Pursuing a BS, MS, or Ph.D. degree in Tunneling, Civil, Geological, Mining, or Mechanical Engineering  • Demonstrate a desire for and a probability of success in a career in underground construction/tunneling	
RECIPIENT SELECTION	The Conference Attendance Scholarship is administered by the Underground Construction Association (UCA) and Rapid Excavation and Tunelling Committee (RETC), in conjunction with the Society for Mining, Metallurgy & Exploration Inc. (SME). The scholarship will be awarded based on an evaluation by the committee and approved the by the UCA and RETC Executive Committee. (NOTE: preference will be given to students enrolled in U.S. universities.)
